Clubs

A reminder that children, once signed up for a club, attend every week. For them, the end of the day is at 4.15pm. We remain responsible for their care and welfare, so they need to remain in school on their club days, or considerable time will be spent tracking them down to ensure they are safe. Thank you.

We still have a few places available, so if your child would like to attend, please could you come into the school office as soon as possible so that we can ensure your child has a place. A non-returnable deposit of £35.00 will be required. Thank you.

Uniform

Please can we remind you that children should wear the correct uniform each day, especially suitable **black** shoes (Black/Grey trousers, skirt, white shirt and black shoes). Headgear (ie headbands and ribbons, clips etc) should be modest and unobtrusive.
