All our choirs are led by experience vocal specialists and have many performance opportunities. The choirs are open to singers aged 8 – 19 who attend school/college in Cornwall. There is an annual membership fee of £80 (£100 for the Youth Choir), payable in September each year (subsidies are available for children on Free School Meals, Children in Care and children of Services Families).
