

SCHOOL CLOTHING and JEWELLERY

The school uniform consists of:-

Grey/black trousers,
Royal blue pullovers
White or grey shirts
Warm waterproof coats
Hats (sun protection in summer)

Black shoes

Girls –also... skirts, cardigans, grey/black pinafore blue/white checked summer dresses (weather permitting)

Royal blue pullovers, cardigans, sweatshirts, tracksuits and T-shirts, all with the school badge embroidered on can be ordered from the school office.

All footwear should be black and of a practical and safe nature. Boots, high heels, flimsy sandals and light dolly shoes are not appropriate. Please consider all of these factors when choosing your child's footwear.

Children require shorts, top and plimsolls for P.E. The top should be plain, with no logos or designs, and white or blue in colour. Shorts should be blue. Tracksuit bottoms can be useful during the winter months. These items should be kept in a bag in school, and available at all times.

NB. Reception, Year 1 and 2 pupils take part in ½ an hour of 'Leap into Life' each day, where they are expected only to remove their shoes and socks. PE clothing may be worn much less by these children, but should not indicate that they are not doing regular PE lessons.

Jewellery

The wearing of earrings in school can be very dangerous. If your child has pierced ears then plain studs or sleepers should be worn. No other pierced jewellery is permitted for safety reasons. For some sporting events (eg netball tournaments) no jewellery of any kind is permitted.

Hair

Hair should always be tied back if longer than shoulder length. We request that hair styles are kept simple, as gelled, coloured and highly fashioned hair can be very distracting for children of primary school age – best kept for parties and special occasions.
