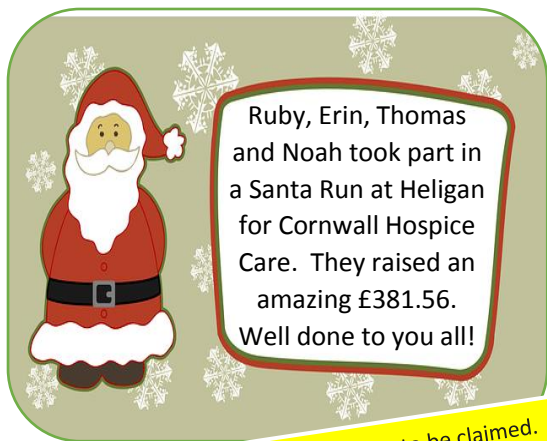
Good Work Awards- November 2019
