Well done to all the children in Year 6 who have worked so hard in their SATs tests this week. We are all very proud of how hard they have worked and were impressed with their determination to do their very best. Thank you to the governors who have been in this week to support with these tests.

Leave of absence

Please note that any leave of absence needs to be applied for at least 14 days prior to the period of absence. A leave of absence will only be granted if the school considers that there are **exceptional circumstances. Please ensure that you complete a leave of absence form which is available from the school office.**

If you decide to still take your child out of school, without permission, the absence will be unauthorised. The Education Welfare Service may be notified of the absence and a Penalty Notice may be issued. A penalty notice can be issued under Section 444A and 444B of the Education Act 1996. This carries a fine of £60 per child per parent if paid within 21 days or £120 if paid after this, but within 28 days. Failure to pay the fine may result in legal action being taken against you.

Age restrictions for Social Media and Video Games

Please can we remind parents that all social media and video games have age limits and parents/children should always abide by these. We have heard that some children in school are now using Snapchat and Facebook (minimum age 13), WhatsApp (minimum age 16) and this is now causing difficulties, where children are sharing inappropriate comments and unkind messages. We are also noting an increase in inappropriate language which the children inform us they have heard on video games they play, particularly Fortnite (minimum age 12).
