

Expressive arts and design

- Use a variety of shapes and construction materials to design and build structures and bridges.
- Use other media such as paint and collage to represent special buildings from all over the world.



Understanding the world

- Discuss why things happen and how things work.
- Deepen understanding of the real world.
- Create experiments when building bridges and testing ideas.
- Compare buildings and structures around the world.

Mathematics

- Use knowledge of numbers to 20 to solve problems.
- Use positional language during play.
- Use vocabulary linked to weighing and measuring.
- Select and name common 2D and 3D shapes when building.
- Develop an understanding of addition and subtraction when solving problems.

PSED

- Focus on turn taking and compromising with others.
- Develop a role play building site and learn to take on other ideas whilst sharing personal ideas.

Communication and Language

- Follow a story with pictures or prompts.
- Explore and re-tell different stories including 'The Three Billy Goats Gruff' and 'The Three Little Pigs'.
- Develop spoken language by creating and role-playing different stories.

Literacy

- Use sounds to read simple words and sentences.
- Apply phonic knowledge to write for different purposes, including lists and labels.

Physical Development

- Develop handwriting and use the correct letter formation in writing.
- Strengthen hand and finger muscles using different fine motor activities.
- In PE the children will be practising their hand eye co-ordination whilst throwing, catching and kicking.
