Reminder re illness

A number of children have recently been absent with diarrhoea and vomiting.

Public Health England offer the following advice:

Keep hydrated

Do not return to school until 48 hours after the last symptom has gone

Remember to wash hands with soap and water

Disinfect frequently touched surfaces

People usually recover within 2-3 days, if symptoms do not resolve after 48 hours, or if you are concerned contact GP by phone or call NHS non-emergency number 111

Application for a Primary School Place – even if already in Minpins

Applications should be made online using the Cornwall Council website www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions or by printing the paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101).
