The aim of this reading spine is to provide an extensive list of books across EYFS, KS1 and KS2 which will be used by class teachers to support the teaching of reading in their classroom. At Indian Queen's Primary School we teach children to read so, in turn, they can read to learn. Reading for pleasure is at the heart of our reading spine and we strive to include a range of texts that will allow our children to progressively broaden their knowledge of the world around them and develop a rich, wide vocabulary that will carry them into secondary school as successful readers. Our text selection allows for a broad and balanced range of authors, text types and genres. We also ensure that each year group will study a specific classic texts, learn about stories from other cultures and study texts that have a range of complexity. Each year group will also study a verse novel or poetry selection.


