

Indian Queens School Parliament 2025-2026 (Eco Council)

09/10/2025 – MPs voted for and badge colour agreed – black and gold. Couldn't get the shield badge so went for long thin badges.

17/10/2025 – Badges on order and talked about Ministries – Scarlett (Health and safety), Hazel (Playgrounds), Coby (Traffic), Lulabelle (Behaviour), Joshua (Assemblies and events) and Landon (Environment) Imogen (Playground equipment monitor). Mirrors in bathroom petition – fix hair, no glass – research small plastic mirrors – unanimous vote. Monkey bars for the playground – passed on to Friends of School. Snow events – snow on grass but not thrown at faces, don't eat the snow, wouldn't like snowmen knocked down, could get slippery, icy no but snow ok, yes because it's fun but no as can get too silly, one class at a time on the snow – unanimous vote. Wellies advised.

3/11/2025 – Badges given out. Appreciation and need to look after. Review of petition forms.

11/11/2025 – Two minute silence generally well respected. Poppy display good. Playgrounds ok, football rough. Running in corridors an issue. 'Remember to...'. Assemblies good. Environment – bit of litter, pond good, climbing tree quite slippery – no throwing small sticks. Transport – ok, Y5/6 gate parking – cars too close.

18/11/2025 – Talked about Parliament Day – gave out letters.

15/1/2026 – Purchased a wormery. Food waste bins to feed the worms. Noticed litter around the site – crisp packets. Posters about not dropping litter/food waste. Sophia/Elsie – Mon. Tues – Roma/Amelia, Weds – Albert/Corey, Thurs – Brooklyn/Hazel, Fri – All.

15/1/2026 – Petition Forms: More PE requested – 2 hours – some classes missing PE. Play equipment in the OEA – money for trips, Reading Area in the OEA - benches, Balls flying around in games – considerate to others – some hitting the ball too hard, PE changes each half term, OEA – muddy area not to be stepped on. Reports: Pupils not respecting equipment, pupils not being kind – following (texting), parking on the road makes driving in difficult, would like a crossing near 5/6 entrance or no parking signs, picking up nails (rusty) reminders about no gum in school, icepacks running out, concerns too many monitors in school.

22/1/2026 – Petition form review and talked about outdoor issues - mud. Spoke about visitors in school.

6/2/2026 – Footballs on roof – people not being sensible not to play. Improving behaviour in school. Washing hands an issue. Brambles coming up in the OEA. Plastic from tress. Assemblies good – slides shows too long. Pushing on grass. Health and safety – balls hitting people. Petition form discussion.
