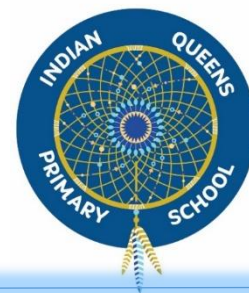

Parent code of conduct

This week, we have had incidents of disagreements between parents happening at drop off and collection. Please can we reinforce that parental behaviour should set the example that we ask from our children. There should not be rude or aggressive behaviour towards other parents and the children should not be subjected to hearing foul language or seeing unacceptable conduct.

The school has the right to refuse parents access to the site if their behaviour is deemed unacceptable and these behaviours will be acted upon.
