#### **Flu Immunisation Programme**

On **Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> November** all children from Reception to Year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the flu vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose.
