

### Mathematics

Make a simple tuck shop for home snacks i.e.  
apple 5p, banana 5p, orange 5p

Biscuits and crisps 10p

Water free, squash 10p and milk 5p

Measure plants around the house.

Practise counting to 50 forwards and  
backwards.

Practice counting/chanting in 2's ,5's and 10's.

Practice number bonds within 20:

$0 + 20 = 20$   $19 + 1 = 20$  etc

### Music

Learn the song and add actions:

I am a squirrel in a tall, tall tree

I like to look around and see, see, see

I am picking acorns for my lunch

I love the way they crunch, crunch,  
crunch.

Sometimes I stretch my arms out high,  
highhigh,

I feel like I can reach the sky, sky, sky.

### English

Write a letter or design a poster persuading people  
not to drop litter in the environment.

Research woodland animals, plants and trees and  
make an information book with labels, captions and  
pictures about their finding.

Read a range of woodland/plant stories such as  
'Peter Rabbit', Little red riding hood, Jack and the  
beanstalk, Hansel and Gretel....

### Science

Think about what plants  
need to grow and write a set  
of instructions on how to care  
for a plant.

### PSHCE

Play 'owls a hunting'.

Pretend to be field  
mice but when they  
hear 'Twit twoo' they  
either freeze or hide  
around the house.

### D&T / Art

Paint/ draw pictures of  
flowers.

Make a 'woodland crown'  
with either natural items  
such as twigs or pictures  
of leaves.
