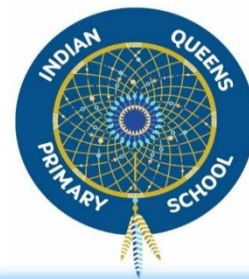

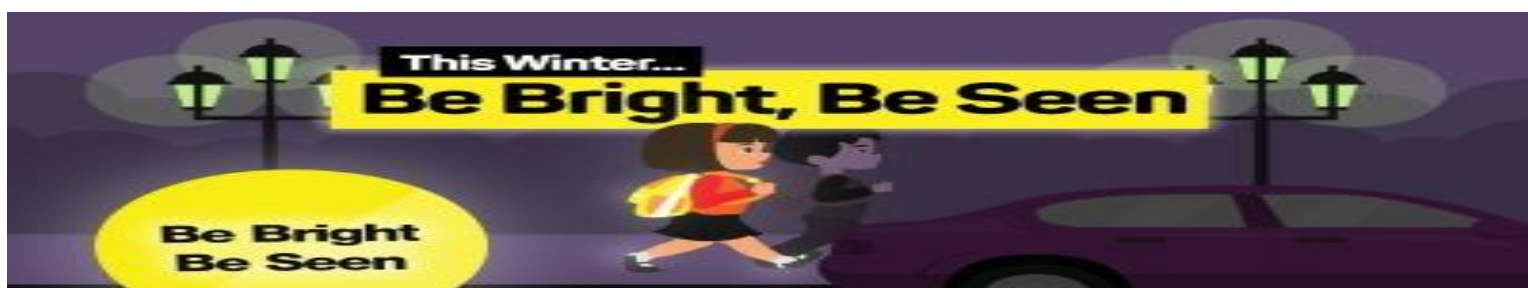

Flu Immunisation

All children in Primary Schools from Reception to year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the Flu vaccine. The vaccination is free and recommended for young children; it is administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose.

PLEASE ENSURE YOU ENTER THE FULL UNIQUE SCHOOL REFERENCE CODE. The code for your child's school is: EE111894

Please submit your consent form by midday on Monday 22nd November to ensure your child receives their vaccination. If you experience any problems accessing the form please telephone 01872 221105 and the team will be happy to help. Please note that as in previous years you must opt into the programme. **If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated.**

Weights and Measurements Programme – Reception & Year 6 only

On Thursday 25th November, the School Nurse will be visiting Reception and Year 6 pupils who are taking part in the Weight and Measurement programme.

School health checks operate on an 'opt out' basis and your child will be weighed and measured unless you return a completed [opt out](#) form (please click on link) **by the 24th November- at the latest.**

If you are happy for your child to be measured, you do not need to do anything.
