## Flu immunisation programme information

This year all children Reception to Year 6 (inclusive) will be offered the flu vaccine. They will be administering the vaccine in school on **Friday 8<sup>th</sup> November**. It is a free service, administered by a quick and simple spray up the nose. You must opt in online by **1<sup>st</sup> November** to give your consent. If a consent form is not submitted your child will not be vaccinated. ## Application for a Secondary School Place - Year 6 only

If you have a child in Year 6, it is important that you make an application for your preferred choice of secondary school starting in September 2020. Your child will not be allocated a place unless you make an application and are offered a place. Please register your preference online at <a href="www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions">www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions</a> or complete a paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101). If you have any concerns about this or would like assistance please pop into the office and we will arrange to help you complete the application. **The deadline for applications is 31**st **October 2019.** 

#### Application for a Primary School Place - even if already in Minpins

Parents of all children whose date of birth is between 1 September 2015 and 31 August 2016 need to apply for a school place for their child **even if their child is already attending Minpins**. Applications should be made online using the Cornwall Council website <a href="https://www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions">www.cornwall.gov.uk/admissions</a> or by printing the paper form available online or from the School Admissions Team (0300 1234 101). If you would like assistance in completing your application please speak to the staff in Minpins or the school office. **The deadline for applications is 15<sup>th</sup> January 2020**.
