As you are aware, SATs (Standard Attainment Tests) are fast approaching and will take place from Tuesday $9^{\rm th}$ to Friday $12^{\rm th}$ May. Staff and children have been working hard to prepare and we hope to make the experience as successful as we can. The timetable for these is as follows:

Weds 10th May 2023	English Reading Test - 60 minutes
Thurs 11th May 2023	Mathematics Arithmetics (Paper 1) - 30 minutes Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 2) - 40 minutes
Friday 12th May 2023	Mathematics Reasoning (Paper 3) - 40 minutes

Therefore, to ease worries about being late, we invite Year 6 pupils to arrive (normal entrance) at 8:20am so they can come in and settle before the rest of the school. We will provide a light breakfast (a selection of nutritious snacks) which will be funded by Friends of the School and will complement their breakfast and calm their nerves.

To help children perform at their best, please ensure they get a good night's rest each evening and keep everything as calm as possible in the mornings as their anxiety levels may be heightened.

The children are aware that these tests are designed to measure progress from KS1 to KS2 and to inform secondary schools about individual's abilities so that provision can be planned to best meet their needs. The tests are nothing to worry about but are the first experience of formal testing for the children: the best way to approach them is with a sense of 'try your best and remain calm'.


