## **DfE School Census Day Harvest** **Lunch- Thursday 1st October**

The DfE School Census takes place on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October 2020, with a delicious lunch consisting of a hot dog (meat or vegetarian), and baked doughnut for dessert.

Schools are funded by the government for Universal Infant Free School Meals (UIFSM) and the number of pupils which receive a meal on this day determines how much funding the school receives.

It is imperative to the school budget that as many pupils as possible in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 order a school meal on this day so that the school receives this funding for meals for the forthcoming year.

**All pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 will be ordered a meal for Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> October, regardless of whether they bring in a packed lunch. This will ensure that the school receives the maximum funding for UIFSM.**
