Add a 2-digit number and 1-digit number, crossing 10.

Add two 2-digit numbers without crossing 10.

Subtract a 2-digit number from a 2-digit number without crossing 10.

Number bonds to 100 using tens and ones.

Count, compare and find the total of different coins.

Music

Listen to and appraise the song 'Ho ho ho', plus a range of songs by Elvis Presley, Frank Sinatra and The Jackson 5.

Learn to sing the songs.

Play instruments.

History and Geography

Learn about changes beyond living memory, such as how the Victorians changed Britain.

Learn about significant Victorian individuals such as Queen Victoria and Florence Nightingale.

Investigate and compare aerial maps from today and the Victorian times.
