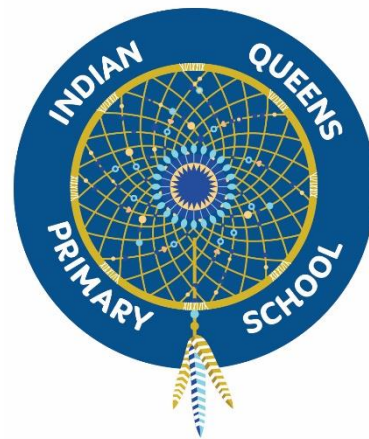

Reporting Absence

Thank you for continuing to inform us when children are going to be absent from school.

The EWO (Education Welfare Officer) has informed us we must have a full reason for absence- it is not only important for the safeguarding of the child who is absent, but also for anyone in school who may be affected by contagious illnesses such as chicken pox, sickness bugs etc. By letting us know the reason, it helps us to keep our attendance data up to date and to track whether there are any illnesses circulating which need to be dealt with on a health and safety basis.
