Personal Social and Emotional Development:

During this topic we will be talking about families and what makes us special. We will be discussing how we are all different.

We will be developing independence and learning how to zip up our own coats and how to wash up our dishes after snack time.

Communication and Language:

We will share our 'All About Me Box' with our new friends and adults.

We will be discussing the things that we like to do with our families and beginning to listen to others.

In our 'Home Corner' we will be applying language and learning how to share ideas with others.

Physical Development:

Weekly PE lessons involving a range of fundamental skills including being able to negotiate space.

We will be learning how to dance to music using ribbons!

We will be developing our gross and fine motor skills through activities such as digging in the sand pit, various playdough activities and learning how to write our names.

Literacy:

In literacy we will be exploring various stories relating to families and homes. We will be learning how to talk about parts of the story that we liked.

We will be learning how to tell stories based on pictures and what we can see and will be storytelling every day.

How To Support Your Child at Home:

Read with your child EVERY DAY and make reading fun!

Encourage independence when getting dressed, putting on shoes and socks and zipping up their coat.

Talk to your child about their day and try to limit screen time as much as possible.
