

End of day arrangements

Absence and attendance

Attendance rules have tightened and we must have a full reason for children's absence (sickness, flu, cold etc.). We cannot accept 'unwell' as a reason.

We have an increasing number of parents asking to collect children early (especially Friday afternoons). Please remember this should only be in exceptional circumstances and with prior agreement.

All persistent absence and lateness will be followed up by the Education Welfare Officer.

Home School Review meetings

Our first home school review meetings of the year will be held over 2 weeks (due to other staff training that needs to be undertaken) between **Monday 27th September and Friday 8th October**. Sadly, due to Cornwall's 'Enhanced Response' status, we have been informed that these meetings will again have to take place virtually. Specific appointments will be sent out next week.

Nut free school

A further reminder, we now have staff members and children in the school with serious (life-threatening) airborne nut allergies. So, we must insist that no nut products are brought into school, including peanut butter sandwiches, chocolate spread (that contains nut) and cereal bars. If nut items are brought in, children will be asked not to eat them and the items will be returned home.
